OBJECTIVES AND AIMS

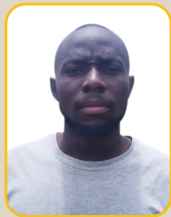

Important to note

Cases of impersonation, opportunists, falsification of documents and information, fraudulent access or whenever discovered either at registration or afterwards will lead to automatic cancellation of registration

The names to use for registration

The names to use when registering should be those which appear on your national identity card and in full including the abbreviated ones

Initials are not accepted

Change of names, seasons of work, programs should be done following the recommended steps and procedures

Registering of hired land or rented land should have enough evidence to proof the ownership and agreement with LCI, LCII, and LCIII letters attached registration of land with disputes should bare court orders

No registration of different persons on one program until authorities have had a meeting about it

Registration of clients will be done by submitting application forms through the LCI, for individual projects. For group projects will be at our office through the operations manager but with the LCI recommendation letter

Registered entities will be asked to open up bank accounts

Registration will make the beginning of compiling information from the client. Projects of individuals will also require the monitoring of clients life round to prevent interferences

Registered members will be advised in order to prevent external interferences like execution by authorities

Registration fees and other minor dues will be verified by evaluation officer at the office

Registration of more than one project and from different geographical location will be done with financial able clients after the evaluation officer has finished his assessment

Projects under the supervision of other organizations and institutions will be registered with a recommendation letter from those serving organizations

Only registered members will be allowed to access the use of tri Africa facilities

All registered clients will be provided with a copy of TRI-Africa rules and regulations for outside projects

Each client will pay for the following items

Identity card

TRI-Africa booklet

Overcoat and T-Shirt

It is also responsible for the disciplining of TRI-Africa officials and clients including partners

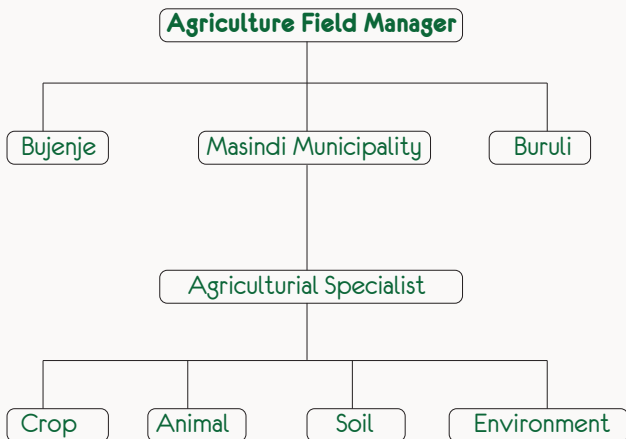
6. ICT Department

SHORT NOTES ABOUT THE AFORE MENTIONED DEPARTMENTS ABOVE.

Crop science

We as TRI-Africa our main intension is to improve on quality and quantity of crop production in Uganda. This will be achieved through research so that to introduce improved varieties which can grow very fast, resistant to pests and disease and also adoptable to our African environment. This will enable farmers produce high yields thus improving their livelihood.

Farmers also need to be taught simple methods of obtaining high yielding varieties example selection method, cross breeding methods etc.

Famers also needs to adopt the use of pesticide, insecticides and herbicides to control weeds, pests and insects since there is main contributors of low yields to most farms.

New techniques like grafting in orchards example mangoes need to be taught to farmers to obtain better varieties, there is also need to teach farmers especially those in urban areas with limited land for agriculture about urban farming skills where you can use polythene bags, plastic pipes and other materials to grow crops in a limited space.

Animal Science.

Animal husbandry has greatly remained behind and we as TRI-Africa our emphasis will be put on cattle, goat's poultry and Piggery. Under this sector we are going to improve on the genetics of the animals through different techniques i.e. cross breeding program, introduction of different breeds,

selection and many other methods. This will also help to improve on production and productivity of these animals in terms of eggs, meat, milk and other products.

More emphasis will also be put on the treatment of animals and vaccination so that to curb disease infestation; under this program we will embrace village to village vaccination and treatment as well.

Soil science

Soil is the highest contributor in agricultural sector. Without soil, production is impossible, so there is a need also to intervene in soils since they contribute greatly to our production.

Under this section we are going to carry out research about our soils to come up with a soil album of Masindi district so that each parish soils are analyzed. In terms of soil P.H, drainage, water holding capacity, organic matter content and other soil components so as we can determine which crop can perform best in which soils.

Environmental science.

This is a very sensitive section and less priority has been put on this section yet without a favorable environment agriculture is less productive. We as TRI Africa we shall make sure that people engage in agriculture without destroying the quality of the environment this will be achieved through employing new farming technologies which favors the environment like zero tillage, use of organic fertilizers example compost, farm yard manure to limit use inorganic fertilizers, like N.P.K, CAN which are highly acidic at the end kill micro and macro organisms which are important in soil formation and fertility.

Farmers will also be taught on new organic farming methods which do not require use of pesticides, insecticides, fertilizers and many other acidic media used in farming.

More emphasis will also be put on weather focus by the weather department to predict when farmers are plant, prepare their garden so that to reduce on the losses farmers face due to poor predictions made on seasons.

Message from God

THE KEY STUDY OF RESEARCH CARRIED OUT ON POULTRY KEEPING IN MASINDI DISTRICT AREA

Household demographic (household education, land side source of income, position at home and period of keeping indigenous kitchen) these have not contributed to the enhancement of productivity of indigenous poultry in Masindi district.

There is limited investment in indigenous poultry production due to limited income since majority of farmers keep kitchen for food not as a necessary business. Production system (free range) which is preferred greatly affects

productivity since it exposes birds to pests, parasites, predators and this system is coupled with poor feeding and housing which limits egg production, weight gain and growth of birds.

There is limited intervention by government in enhancing productivity of indigenous birds. And this can be evidenced by limited extension workers in the study area. Poor methods of disease and parasites control i.e. the use of herbs which are not infective and use of ash to control parasites.

In conclusion farmers face many challenges including diseases, theft, predators, parasites, conflicts with neighbors and common diseases are Newcastle the most common, coccidiosis, marek, chicken pox and gumboro.

RECOMMENDATION

- ❖ Basing on the research we sited out these recommendations;
- ❖ Enhance education and awareness programs to farmers as it is critical for uptake of new technologies and innovations.
- ❖ Provision of extension services to farmers through extension workers, radio stations, televisions since those services are limited.
- ❖ Encourage farmers to form groups so that they can access credit facilities supplement on limited capital they have.
- ❖ Vaccination programs at village levels so that farmers can check birds for vaccination to control diseases.
- ❖ Encourage breeding programs e.g. selection breeding of best performing birds to mate so that they can produce better off springs.
- ❖ Culling (removal of sick birds) is encouraged to reduce on disease spread in case of outbreak.

- ❖ Farmers are encouraged to construct permanent structures to reduce the spread of diseases, theft and conflicts with neighbors.
- ❖ Encourage farmers to take indigenous chicken and production as a business as there is high market for chicken in the study area.
- ❖ Cross breeding between local chicken and exotic breeds to improve on progeny of the local chicken

The above afore mentioned solutions can be put in place by the agriculture department of TRI Africa
